

WINTER SNOW PRECEDURE NOTICE!!

Residents of the Fox Hollow Condominium Assoc. The winter season is upon us and everyone needs to make sure they are familiar with the procedures so the winter season flows smoothly for all involved. The following is the snow procedure as well as some important information to know in the event of a snow storm.

- 1- Please remove all items including mats, decorations; etc so shoveled areas can be done so properly.**
- 2- Depending on the conclusion time of the storm, more often than not, parking spaces will be cleaned the following day unless storms end well before nightfall. This is to ensure everyone's safety and quality.**
- 3- In the event a storm ends after dark or before sunrise. Your parking space clean up time will be at 9am. Please make sure you are aware of the time and available to move all vehicles. Note that we cannot get to every building exactly at 9am. If you have multiple vehicles, you need to make arrangements for them to be moved if you are not available. *Contractors **WILL NOT** move vehicles for tenants.***
- 4- Parking spaces will be cleaned by building. Contractors will either knock on your door or honk their horns to signal you to move your vehicle out of your space. Please wait for your parking space to be cleaned and move your car back immediately afterward to create spaces for others to move. Do not move your care until told as it creates lack of space for others and contractors trying to do their job.**
- 5- Failure to follow procedures will result in your vehicle being towed at the owner's expense. If a tow truck cannot get here in a timely fashion your space will be worked around to the best of the contractor's ability and you will be responsible to clean your own space when you return.**
- 6- Parking on the main road and club house area of Fox Hollow Way during inclement weather or during clean up time will result in your vehicle being towed at the owners expense. This area gets extremely tight during storms and limits where snow can be put. Repeat offenders will be noted and sent to the management company for further action.**
